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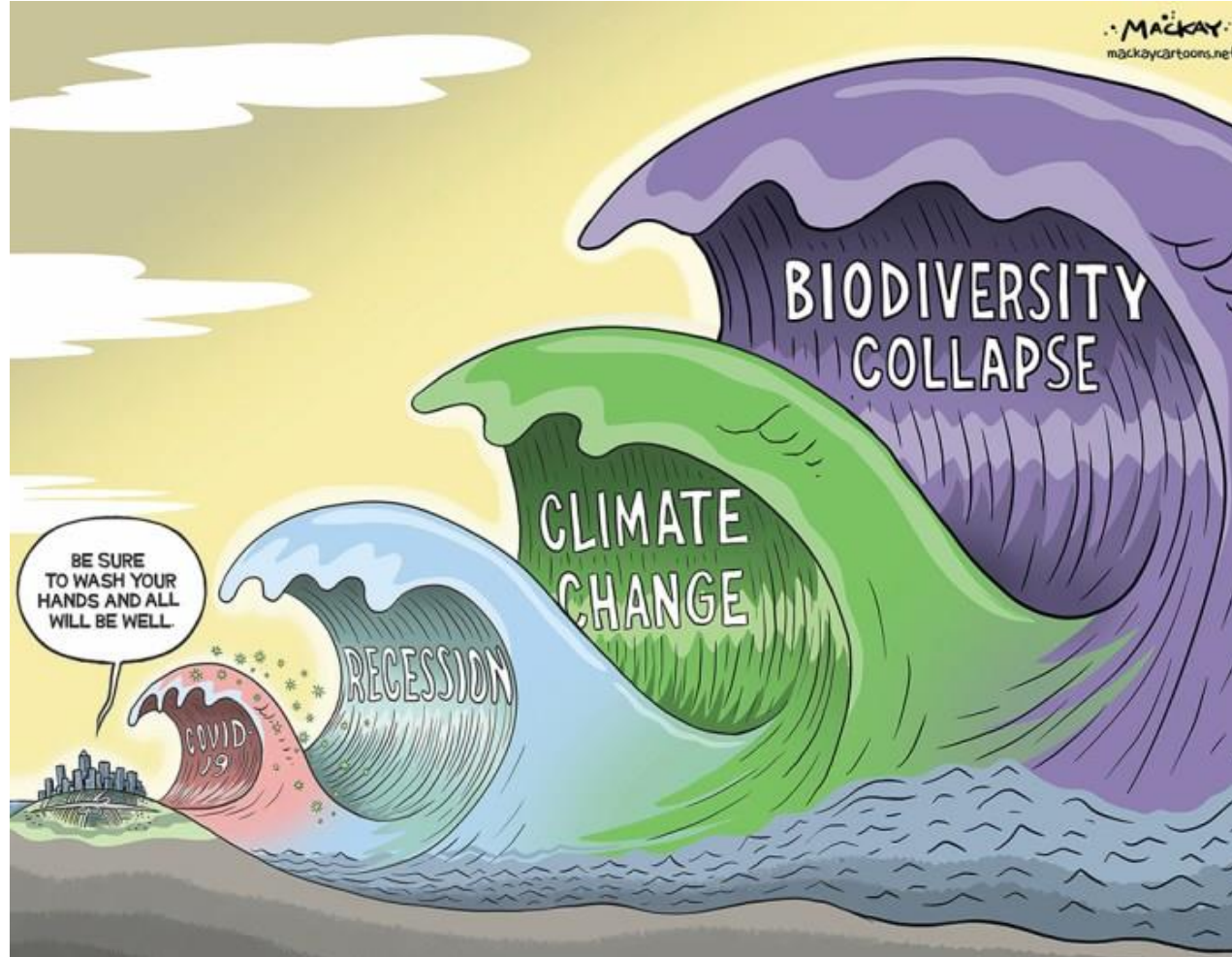

- We heard the challenge from coaches in 2019
- We worked with other professional bodies to create the Joint Statement published on 29th May 2020.

- There are now 10 signatories
- We co-hosted one of 6 Webinars in November 2020 to engage coaches, mentors, supervisors and coaching psychologists in a debate
- In January 2021 we committed to set up an EMCC Working Group on Climate Change with membership from several countries.

- There are a range of views in the profession.
- There is a desire for professional bodies to continue to hold space for debate.
- There was a view that our Code of Ethics and Accreditation could be amended to better cover this issue.
- Those more active on the Eco-Cycle are looking for practical tools and opportunities to share practice.
